

QU'Y AVAIT-IL SOUS L'HÔTEL-DIEU ? WHAT WAS THERE UNDER THE HÔTEL-DIEU?

Confier au groupe Eiffage, la reconversion de l'Hôtel-Dieu, propriété des Hospices civils de Lyon et site emblématique de la ville, s'accompagne depuis juillet 2011 d'opérations d'archéologie préventive.



Prescrites par l'Etat (DRAC Rhône-Alpes, Service Régional de l'Archéologie) et conduites par le Service archéologique de la Ville de Lyon (SAVL), ces interventions viennent progressivement enrichir l'histoire de ce site remarquable et des occupations qui s'y sont succédé depuis l'Antiquité. A travers le passé de cette berge du Rhône qu'elles font ressurgir, se précise également l'histoire du fleuve, dont l'évolution au fil des siècles a contribué à dessiner la Presqu'île lyonnaise.



The Hôtel-Dieu, the conversion work for which was awarded to the Eiffage group, and which is the property of the Hospices civils de Lyon and one of the emblematic sites in the town, has also since July 2011 been the scene of preventive archaeological operations. Ordered by the State (DRAC Rhône-Alpes, Regional Archaeology Department) and carried out by the Service archéologique de la Ville de Lyon (SAVL), this archaeological work has progressively contributed to the richness of the history of this remarkable site and of its inhabitants stretching back to Ancient History. The resurrection of the past of this bank of the river Rhône has also been a way of recounting the history of the river itself, which, as it has evolved over the centuries, has contributed to the complexion of Lyon's Presqu'île.
